## Notable U.S. Cities of the Gilded Age

The Gilded Age increased the population of cities due to industrialization. New industrial jobs attracted both farm workers and new immigrants, who swelled the size of eastern and mid-west cities. As train travel grew more prevalent, both industrialization and immigrants spread west, increasing the size of western cities. While some cities grew into centers of industry, other cities, like Newport RI, became summer resorts for the Gilded Age's wealthy elite.
